

Campus Prayer Walking Guide

Organize a campus prayer walk with some friends or grab a campus map and do a “virtual” prayer walk. Keep in mind that prayer walking does not always need to be a planned event. We can pray anytime and anywhere. The Bible says to “Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you” (1 Thess. 5:16-18, ESV).

Make prayer walking a way of life. Every time you walk across your college campus, pray for the students and professors around you. Ask Him how you should pray for your school, then pray what comes to your mind. Pray students and professors will come to know Jesus as Truth, Creator, Light of the World, the Word, Great Physician, Savior, and Lord.

So put on a pair of comfortable shoes, go for a walk, and pray without ceasing as you observe your campus from God’s viewpoint.

PRAISE AND WORSHIP

- Begin your prayer walk by reading this verse: “May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit” (Romans 15:13, NIV).
- Praise God because He is our hope and glory (Romans 15:13; Hebrews 1:3).
- Pray He will fill you with all joy, peace, and hope by the power of the Holy Spirit (Romans 15:13).

- Pray that BCM will be like the city on a hill that cannot be hidden (Matthew 5:14).
- Pray all BCM students will love one another so that all on campus will see our love and unity (John 13:34-35).
- Pray God will raise up bold BCM students and other Christians to share the gospel with students on campus (Philippians 1:14).

SCHOOL OF BUSINESS, LAW & JOURNALISM

- Pray the *Spirit of Truth* will guide Business, Law, and Journalism majors into all truth (John 16:13).
- Pray the Lord will give them good judgment, make fair business decisions, and speak words of wisdom and righteousness (Proverbs 16:10-13).
- Pray the Lord will raise up strong Christians to lead in the marketplace, in our courts, and in our nation’s media (Colossians 3:23-24; Proverbs 16:3; Exodus 18:21).



SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY



- Pray all engineers and IT majors will recognize Jesus as the Light of the World, so they will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life (John 8:12).
- Pray they will not only pay attention to detail in their studies and work but will study God's word with focused minds. (Isaiah 28:9-10).
- Pray they will be strengthened with all power according to His glorious might so that they may have great endurance and patience (Colossians 1:11).

SCHOOL OF FINE ARTS AND MUSIC

- Pray all Fine Arts and Music majors will come to know Jesus as Savior and Lord. May they know the God of glory, majesty, power, and authority (Jude 1:25).
- Pray all students realize that every good gift and every perfect gift comes from the Father of lights. May they use their gifts to honor Him (James 1:17).
- Pray students will learn to rejoice and praise the Lord with joy, singing and instruments (1 Samuel 18:6).



SCHOOL OF HEALTH SCIENCES



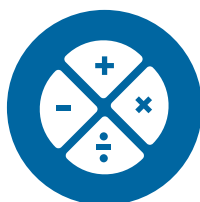
- Pray health science majors will call on Jesus as the Great Physician and the Fountain of Life (Matthew 9:12; Exodus 15:26; Psalm 36:9).
- Pray the Lord will raise up doctors and scientists who will seek spiritual wisdom to find cures for diseases (Matthew 4:23).
- Pray they will believe God is the creator of all things, He made us in His image, and all human life is valuable from conception to old age. (Genesis 1:1; Revelation 4:11; Genesis 1:27; Jeremiah 1:5).

SCHOOL OF LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE

- Pray all Language and Literature majors will accept Jesus, the Word, as Savior and Lord (John 1:1).
- Pray they will learn godly wisdom and use Your word as a lamp to their feet and a light to their path (Psalm 110:105).
- Pray they will delight in God's word and meditate on it night and day (Psalm 1:2).



SCHOOL OF MATHEMATICS



- Pray all Mathematics majors will know Jesus as the Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. Ask the Lord to grant them everlasting life (Revelation 21:6).
- Pray they will be like minded, have the same love towards one another, act in one accord and have one purpose, which is to follow Jesus Christ (Philippians 2:2).
- Pray they seek after godly relationships and marriages because a chord of three cannot be quickly broken (Ecclesiastes 4:12).

SCHOOLS OF SCIENCE

- Pray all Science majors will acknowledge God as Creator who made the heavens and their hosts, the earth and all that is on it, the seas and all that is in them, and as the giver of life (Nehemiah 9:6).
- Pray they will praise God because He stretches out the north over empty space and hangs the earth over nothing (Job 26:7).
- Pray the Lord will grant them wisdom to find cures for disease, scientific breakthroughs and discoveries which bring Him glory (Revelation 4:11; James 1:5; Ephesians 1:17-18).



SCHOOLS OF SOCIAL SCIENCE



- Pray all Social Science majors will call on Jesus as their Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, and Prince of Peace (Isaiah 9:6).
- Pray they learn to cast all their cares and anxieties on God so they can help counsel others to do the same (Philippians 4:6-7; 1 Peter 5:7).
- Pray the Lord will raise up Christian politicians, lawyers and judges who will walk in integrity and make just laws and decisions based on His word (Proverbs 16:10-13).

DEPARTMENT OF ATHLETICS

- Pray all athletes will know God as their Rock, Fortress, Deliverer and Defender (Psalm 18:2; Deuteronomy 32:4).
- Pray all athletes and students repent and return, so their sins may be blotted out (Acts 3:19).
- Pray that all athletes and spectators will see the crowds as Jesus saw them, which is to have compassion because they are like sheep without a shepherd. May they realize that salvation in Jesus Christ is more important than winning (Matthew 9:36).



STUDENT CENTER



- Pray all students will repent of their sins and accept Jesus as their Lord and Savior (Acts 2:38).
- Pray Christians will be a light for international students, to boldly speak the gospel to them (Acts 13:47; Isaiah 42:6; Acts 4:29).
- Pray the Lord will provide for students who have financial difficulties (Matthew 6:33-34).
- Pray Christians will have the freedom to meet on campus and never lose their freedom of speech (Galatians 5:13; 2 Corinthians 3:17; 1 Peter 2 16-17).
- Pray God will pour out His Spirit on our college campuses in Georgia (Acts 2:17).
